## Jesus' Friends Praised Him

Luke 19:28-40

#### It was time for a special celebration in Jerusalem.

Bible story

Many people were hurrying down the road. Some of these people had heard Jesus preach and had seen him heal people who were sick. Soon the people heard a slow clippety clop, clippety clop, clippety clop. Jesus was riding on a don-

key! His disciples were walking beside Him. Jesus' friends wanted Him to know how much they loved Him. The friends hurried along the road.

Some friends took big branches off of nearby palm trees and spread the branches on the road in front of the donkey. Other friends waved the palm branches in the air. (Show picture 19-7.) "Hosanna! Hosanna!" everyone shouted. Even the boys and girls shouted, "Hosanna!" and sang happy praise songs to Jesus.

The people were very happy to see Jesus. They were happy for all the wonderful things He had done. They wanted to praise Jesus for His love and care. Jesus is in Heaven now, but He still loves boys and girls. And Jesus loves to hear children sing to Him!
